FEBRUARY DIARY

Lent is the period of 40 days before Easter which reflects the 40 days which Jesus spent in the wilderness preparing for his ministry while facing the temptations which could lead him to abandon his mission and calling. *Just pause and pray while you think of him spending all that time in the desert.* Those days do not count Sundays as we celebrate the Resurrection every Sunday of the year.

The first day of Lent is called Ash Wednesday. This year that is Wednesday 22nd February, when we are invited to join a team service at St. Peter's church in the evening. Lent is traditionally a time for introspection, self-examination, repentance and almsgiving.
